The genus *Ortholaba* (Hymenoptera: Ichneumonidae: Diacritinae) with description of a new species

Abstract

Two species of the genus *Ortholaba* are reported. One, *Ortholaba laevis* collected from Jilin province, China, is new to science. A key to the species of *Ortholaba* is presented.

Introduction

Ortholaba Townes, 1969 (Ichneumonidae: Diacritinae) is a small genus, with only one species, Ortholaba tenuis Townes, 1969, distributed in Japan (Townes, 1969) and Russia (Yu & Horstmann, 2004). Diacritinae includes three genera, Cressonia Dasch, 1992 with one Nearctic species, Diacritus Förster 1869 with three Palaearctic species. The biology of this subfamily is unknown. In the present paper one new species of Ortholaba is described from Jilin province, China.

Types are deposited in Insect Museum, General Station of Forest Pest Management (GSFPM), State Forestry Administration, Shenyang, P. R. China. The specimens of *O. tenuis* Townes are deposited in Osaka Museum of Natural History (OMNH), Osaka, Japan. The morphological terminology mostly follows that used by Gauld (1997).
