Abstract

The Oriental Teratomyzidae (Diptera) are reviewed. *Teratomyza formosana* sp. nov. is described and compared to *T. chinica* Yang. *Poecilovitila* gen. nov. (type species: *P. elegans* sp. nov.), a genus related to *Vitila* McAlpine & Keyzer is described, and includes eleven new species *P. barbata* sp. nov., *P. brevicornis* sp. nov., *P. bulbiscapus* sp. nov., *P. defecta* sp. nov., *P. elegans* sp. nov., *P. erugata* sp. nov., *P. hindustanica* sp. nov., *P. japonica* sp. nov., *P. taiwanica* sp. nov., *P. thaili* sp. nov., *P. variegata* sp. nov.).
