# Review of the leafhopper genus *Taperus* Li & Wang (Hemiptera: Cicadellidae: Evacanthinae) from China, with description of three new species

### Abstract

The Oriental leafhopper genus *Taperus* Li & Wang and its type species are redescribed, together with three new species, *T. bannaensis*, **sp. n.**, *T. quadragulatus*, **sp. n.** and *T. luchunensis*, **sp. n.**, are described and illustrated. In addition, *T. flavifrons* (Matsumura) (*Onukia*), **comb. n.** is proposed, and *Taperus bimaculatus* Cai & Shen, *T. discolor* Cai & Shen and *T. lanpingensis* Li & Wang are transferred to *Convexana* Li. A checklist and a key to all species of *Taperus* are provided.

### Introduction

Evacanthinae (*sensu* Dietrich, 2004), a relatively small leafhopper subfamily, includes tribes Evacanthini, Nirvanini, Balbillini and Pagaroniini. The genus *Taperus* Li & Wang, 1994 belongs to the tribe Evacanthini with *Taperus fasciatus* Li & Wang as its type species. Li & Wang (1994) described another two species, and Cai & Shen (1997, 1999) added *T. bimaculatus* Cai & Shen and *T. discolor* Cai & Shen to the genus, respectively. Later, Li & Wang (2001) described the sixth species, *T. lanpingensis* Li & Wang, for the genus.

In the present paper the genus *Taperus* is reviewed, its type species is redescribed and three new species are described. In addition, *Taperus flavifrons* (Matsumura) (*Onukia*) **comb. n.** is proposed and three species formerly placed in *Taperus* are removed to the genus *Convexana* Li.
